Q. 1      **WHAT CAUSED YOU TO WRITE THIS BOOK: *THE SETTLEMENT GAME: How to Settle an Estate Peacefully and Fairly?***

A.      I'll touch on my story – growing up – advice from my father (an attorney) and our personal experiences of settling the estate of our parents.

Q. 2      **IN CHAPTER THREE OF "*THE SETTLEMENT GAME*" YOU MENTION SOME 'GROUND RULES'. TELL US ABOUT SOME OF THESE.**

A.      There are three or four topics I might discuss:  
a.      Only immediate heirs involved.  
b.      Commit to a common goal to keep peace.  
c.      Do not remove anything from the home.  
d.      System of organization

Q. 3      **LET'S SAY WE HAVE PEOPLE OUT THERE WHO ARE FACING THIS SITUATION SOON – WHAT WOULD YOU RECOMMEND THAT THEY DO FIRST.**

A.      I'll suggest reading the book and why – how it gets things said that need to be Said, without anyone having to do the talking. Other suggestions involve basic Understanding of personality differences.

Q. 4      **WHAT IF IT'S TOO LATE - IN OTHER WORDS - WHAT IF A FAMILY HAS ALREADY BEEN THROUGH THIS AND NOW THEY HAVE DAMAGED RELATIONSHIPS FROM THE EXPERIENCE. CAN "*THE SETTLEMENT GAME*" OFFER ANY HELP FOR THESE PEOPLE?**

A.      This is probably the most important angle. I'll discuss prevention – how to keep your children from facing some of the same problems.
